The Social Committee ask all members to furnish finger foods and desserts.

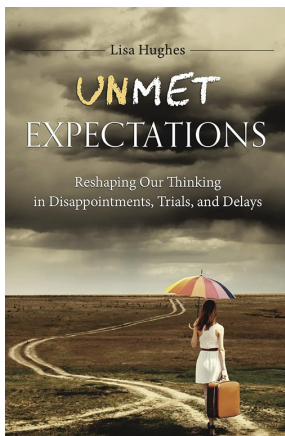
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD SHOEBOX PROCESSING CENTER ATLANTA
